

Bar Memorial Scholarship

The Bar Memorial Scholarship Fund (hereinafter called 'the Scholarship') was founded by the members of the Singapore Bar in memory of fellow members who perished in the First World War.

The Law Society of Singapore (hereinafter called the 'Law Society') shall be the trustee of the Scholarship and its funds.

Eligibility for Application

1. The Scholarship shall be an annual award, awarded by the Law Society in accordance with these rules which may be amended by the Law Society from time to time.
2. The Scholarship may be awarded to any candidate who has obtained admission or who is currently taking any full time course of study in any institute of higher learning in Singapore. Other considerations being equal, preference will be given to an undergraduate admitted to, or pursuing, a Bachelor of Law (LLB) course at the National University of Singapore or the Singapore Management University subject to a maximum of \$5,000.00 per annum payable to the Scholarship holder during the first semester of the academic year.
3. The Scholarship shall normally extend over the minimum period required by the Scholarship holder to complete his/her course of study provided that, the Law Society may lengthen or shorten that period at its discretion.
4. The Scholarship may be awarded by the Law Society at its discretion to any candidate provided that, in its deliberation, the Law Society shall take into account the character, financial needs and academic records of the candidates.
5. If in any particular year, the Law Society considers that there is no candidate of sufficient merit, no award shall be made for that year.
6. A candidate for the Scholarship must:
 - a. be a citizen of Singapore;
 - b. be the son or daughter of any person who is or has been employed by any organisation or establishment connected with the legal profession of Singapore; and
 - c. have obtained admission or is currently taking a full-time course or study in any institute of higher learning in Singapore.

Application

7. **The Scholarship is open for application from 1 January to 15 July of each year.**

An **application form** for the Scholarship shall be submitted to the Law Society, marked for the attention of the Senior Assistant Director, Communications with the following documents:

- a. copy of birth certificate of the applicant;
 - b. copy of Singapore NRIC card of the applicant;
 - c. evidence of eligibility under Rules 9 & 10;
 - d. evidence of previous academic/employment records including detailed transcripts;
 - e. one recent passport size photograph of the candidate; and
 - f. two recent testimonials of good character (not from friends, relatives or peers), of whom one shall be an academic reference.
8. For the Scholarship holder to be considered for the award of the Scholarship for the subsequent academic year, the Scholarship holder shall furnish to the Law Society, within 30 days of the date of release of the academic results, a copy of his/her academic transcripts.
 9. The Law Society may revoke or suspend the Scholarship award at any time and for such period as may be deemed appropriate by the Law Society if the conduct or academic performance of the Scholarship holder is considered unsatisfactory and/or unbecoming.
