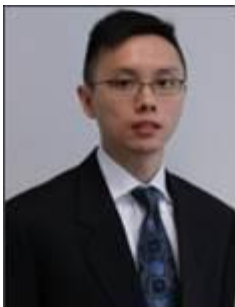
Course description: This programme targets practitioners and in-house counsel who seek an introductory course to competition law.
