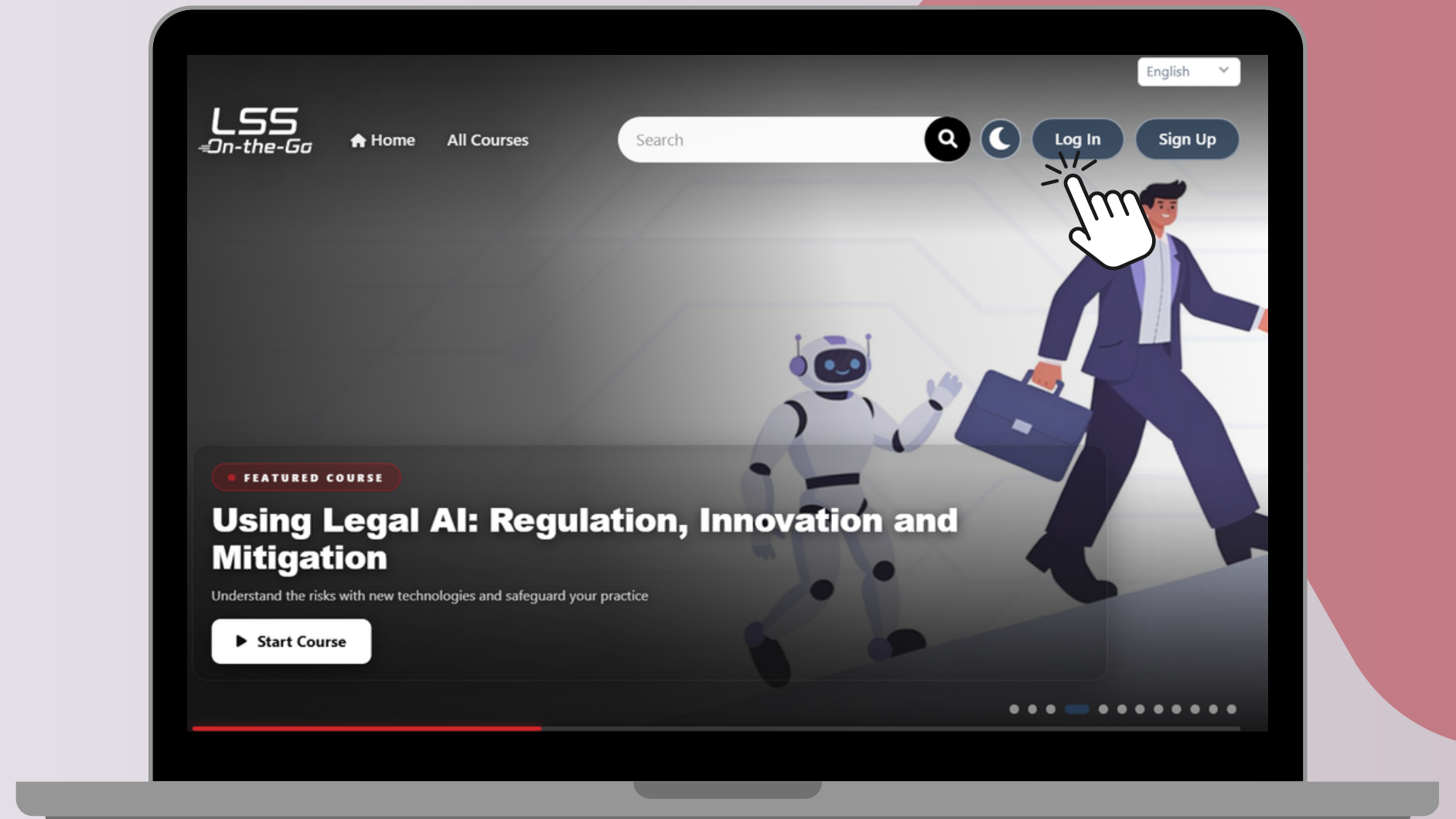

Head over to the [LSS On-the-Go](#) home page to login with the details (email address & password) used for account creation.

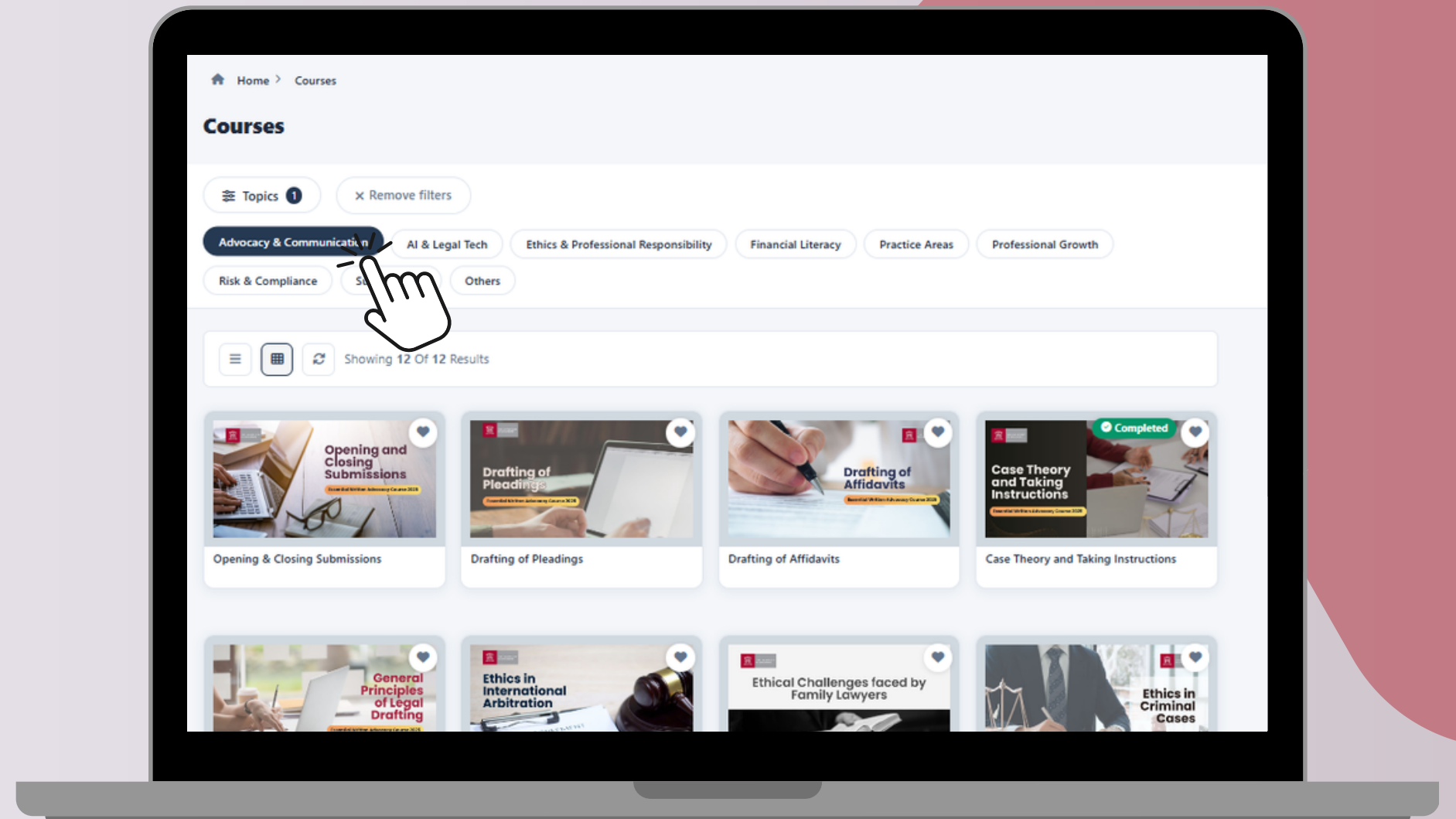

Finding the content you want

To access the available courses, click on “**All courses**”. You will be able to filter the courses according to topics, course status and duration.



Finding the content you want

“Home” Page

Recommended:

This selection features related learning resources based on your past watched.

Playlists:

Curated playlists according to the theme / topic we think might interest you.

Most popular:

These populate according to the most watched courses on the platform.

New Courses:

Find the newest courses available on the platform here.

“All Courses” Page

Topics:

Explore courses across a wide range of topics on advocacy & communication, AI & legal tech, ethics, financial literacy, practice area, and professional growth.

Course Status:

Sort courses according to their completion status.

CPD Duration:

Sort courses according to the course duration. The number of private CPD points is rounded up or down to the nearest full or 0.5 CPD point.



Pro tip: If you are logged in, courses you have started will show up under **“Continue Watching”** on the homepage.

Starting a course

Selecting a course:

When you are ready to start a course, click on the course title or thumbnail.

Click on “**Start Now**” to begin the course.

Completing a course:

To complete the course, you will need to watch all videos and required resources.

Your completion rate is shown on the top of the page. Once you have completed the course (achieved 100% completion), the status will change to **pink**.

Feedback:

Complete when you are done with the course.

Click on “**Start Now**” to begin the course.

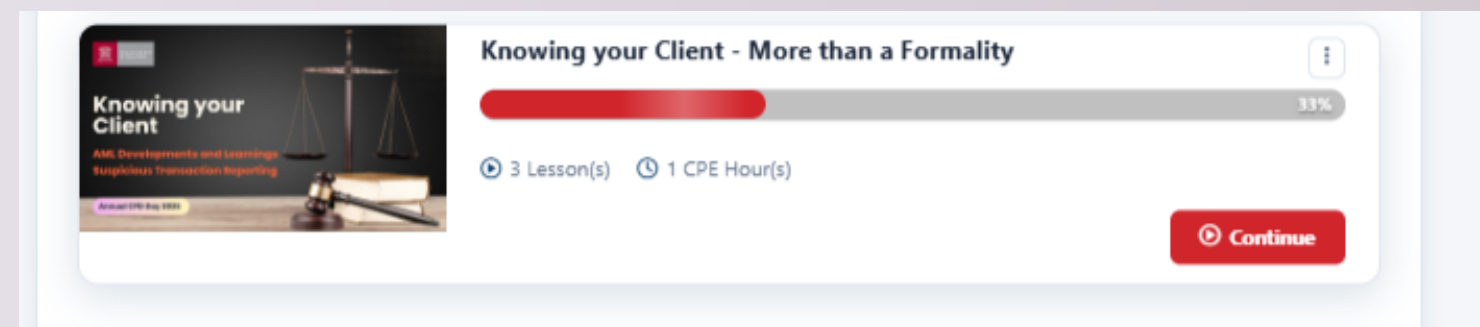
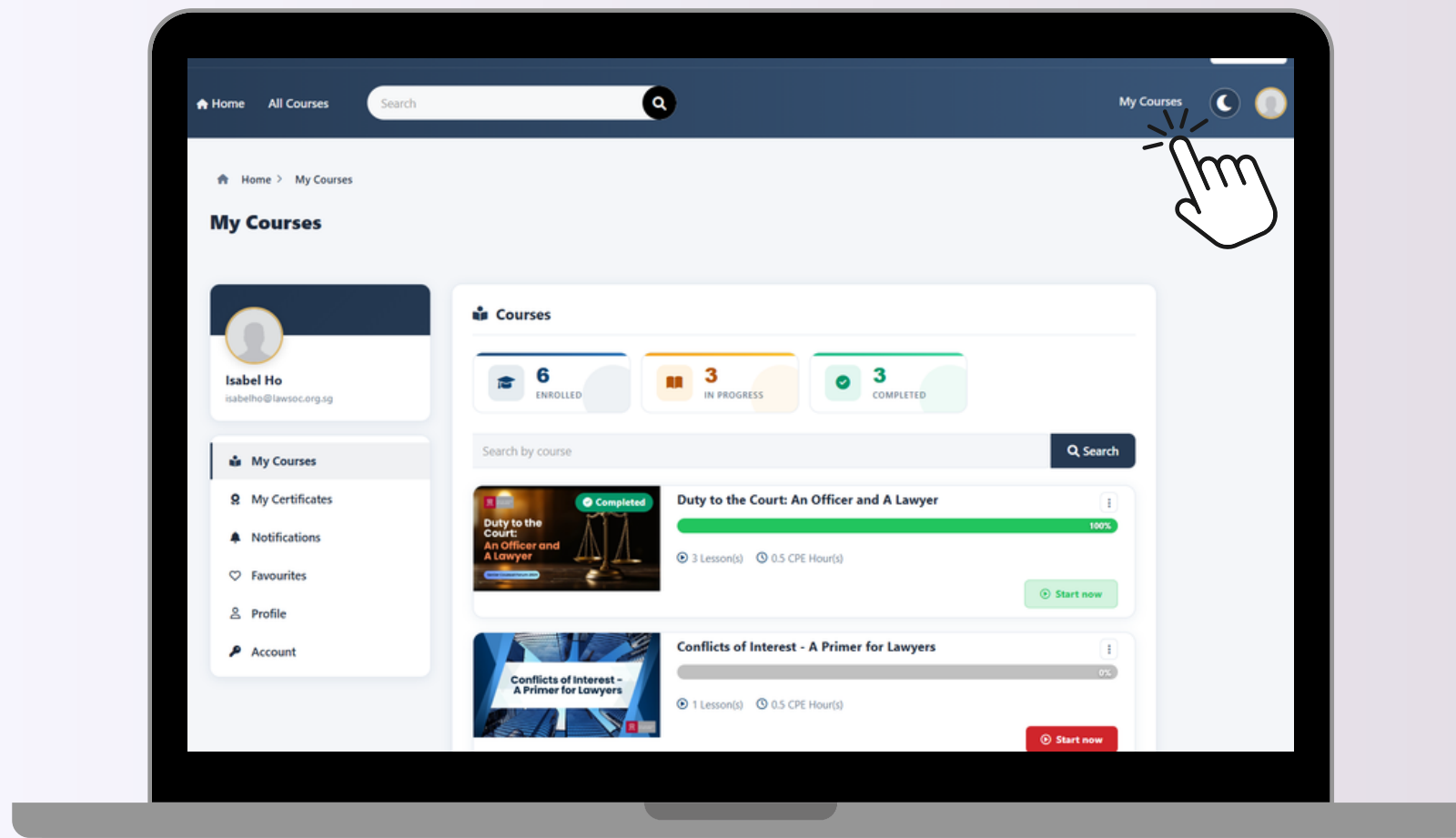
Picking up where you left off
